





VEHICLE RESTORATION

IMPORTANT: You must book an appointment before conducting any formalities at any Provincial Traffic Department.

- Official application form (Available on www.dgt.es)
- Fee of €97.80, except mopeds €27.30. (Payment in cash is not accepted).
- Identification of the applicant:
 - Natural persons: official document accrediting his/her identity and address (ID card, Spanish driving licence, residence card, Passport plus the Foreigner Identification Number).
 - Legal persons: tax identification card of the company accrediting the representation and identity of the person who signs the application (Available on www.dgt.es)
 - Minors or disabled persons: data and signature of the father, mother or guardian, his/her ID card and document accrediting their relationship.
 - If the applicant is not the owner of the vehicle, he/she shall present a documentary proof of ownership (a contract together with the transferor's ID card; the invoice with the company's tax identity number; a notarial document, ...)
 - □ In the event of a vehicle allotted at an auction by the Government Delegation for the National Plan on Drugs, the certificate of sale shall authenticate the successful bidder to apply for the vehicle restoration (Specific information on this issue on www.dgt.es).

Once the documents have been presented, the Traffic Department, if appropriate, shall send a letter to the Inspection Vehicle Centre where the vehicle will be submitted for testing. When the check is completed, the following documents shall be presented:

- Roadworthiness certificate issued by the Inspection Vehicle Centre for that purpose.
- Agricultural vehicles will be required to provide a document proving their registration in the Official Register of Agricultural Machinery of the Autonomous Community, unless they have been registered in the DGT Register of Vehicles.
- Certificate of transport: in case of a bus or a vehicle for transporting goods with a MAM above 6 tonnes and a load capacity exceeding 3.5 tonnes, unless they have been registered in the DGT Register of Vehicles.
- Proof of payment / exemption of the Tax on capital transfers if no invoice is presented and the restoration is applied by a person other than the last owner.
- Proof of payment / exemption from the municipal vehicle tax where the applicant resides

NOTE: If the holder does not submit the documents, it will be necessary to also submit a written authorization signed by him/her, together with his/her original ID card, specifying that this representation is free of charge (model available on www.dqt.es).

If any of the data required above cannot be clearly proven, additional documentation could be requested.
