TEMPORARY DEREGISTRATION. REGISTERING A TEMPORARILY DEREGISTERED VEHICLE

IMPORTANT: You must book an appointment before conducting any formalities at any Provincial Traffic Department, filing the complaint.

TEMPORARY DEREGISTRATION

- **Official application form.** (*Available on www.dgt.es*)
- **Fee** of €8.30 except if the vehicle was stolen. (Payment in cash is not accepted).
- **Identification of the applicant:**
 - Natural persons; official document accrediting his/her identity and address (ID card, Spanish driving licence, residence card, passport plus Foreigner Identification Number).
 - Legal persons: tax identification card of the company accrediting the representation and identity of the person who signs the application. (*Model available on www.dgt.es*)
 - Minors or disabled persons: data and signature of the father, mother or guardian, his/her ID card and document accrediting their relationship.
- **Vehicle documentation:** registration certificate and roadworthiness certificate.
- The existence of an **administrative immobilization of the vehicle** is an impediment to process the deregistration of the vehicle, it needs first to be cancelled.
- **Agricultural vehicles will be required to provide** a document proving their deregistration in the Official Register of Agricultural Machinery of the Autonomous Community.
- Police report of the vehicle theft, where appropriate.
- In general, temporary deregistrations when the vehicle has been stolen are automatically reported by Law Enforcement Officers when

REGISTERING A TEMPORARILY DEREGISTERED VEHICLE

- **Application form, fee and identification of the applicant,** as in *Temporary Deregistration*.
- **Certificate of roadworthiness**
- Certificate of recovery of the stolen vehicle, in case it was deregistered because of theft. In this case no fee will be charged for its registration.
- In general, registrations of a temporarily deregistered vehicle because of theft are automatically reported by Law Enforcement Officers when the vehicle is recovered.
- **Agricultural vehicles will be required to provide** a document proving their registration in the Official Register of Agricultural Machinery of the Autonomous Community, unless they have been registered online in the DGT Register of Vehicles.

NOTE:

- If the holder does not submit the documents, it will be necessary to also submit a written authorization signed by him/her, together with his/her original ID card, specifying that this representation is free of charge (model available on www.dgt.es).

- If any of the data required above cannot be clearly proven, additional documentation could be requested.
