DEFINITE DEREGISTRATION

CARS AND MIXED ADAPTABLE VEHICLES, TRUCKS AND VANS UP TO 3.5 TONNES AND THREE-WHEELED VEHICLES WITH A CYLINDER CAPACITY EXCEEDING 50 CC

COMPULSORILY, deregistrations will be submitted and processed at the CAT (Authorised Treatment Centre. List of centres available on www.dgt.es).

- **Application form** provided by the CAT.
- **Identification of the applicant:**
 - Natural persons; official document accrediting his/her identity and address (ID card, Spanish driving licence, residence card, passport plus Foreigner Identification Number).
 - Legal persons: tax identification card of the company accrediting the representation and identity of the person who signs the application. (Model available on www.dgt.es).
 - Minors or disabled persons: data and signature of the father, mother or guardian, his/her ID card and document accrediting their relationship.
- **Vehicle documentation:** registration certificate and roadworthiness certificate or affidavit of loss or police report of the vehicle documents theft.
- The existence of an **administrative immobilization on the vehicle** is an impediment to deregister the vehicle; it needs first to be cancelled.

The CAT is responsible for the destruction of the vehicle and for recording the deregistration process online in the DGT's Registry of Vehicles.

REST OF VEHICLES (mopeds, motorcycles, heavy vehicles, special vehicles, etc)

IMPORTANT: You must book an appointment before conducting any formalities at any Provincial Traffic Department. **VOLUNTARILY**, applications for deregistering the vehicle may be submitted **at the CAT** (they are processed as in the above procedure) **or at the Provincial Traffic Department**, submitting the relevant documents.

In both cases the applicant shall not pay the fee until the **environmental treatment certificate** is submitted or the vehicle was registered in Spain 15 or more years ago. Otherwise, a fee of €8.30 shall be paid. (Payment in cash is not accepted)

Agricultural vehicles will be required to provide a document proving they have been deregistered in the Official Register of Agricultural Machinery of the Autonomous Community.

NOTE: *If the holder does not submit the documents, it will be necessary to also submit a written authorization signed by him/her, together with his/her original ID card, specifying that this representation is free of charge (model available on www.dgt.es).*

If any of the data required above cannot be clearly proven, additional documentation could be requested.
